

CUT and FILL LAND

Cut and fill land (Ct) is a miscellaneous land type consisting of areas that have been altered by methods other than mining so that the soil characteristics have been completely eliminated. These cut and fill, or dozed, areas have been used largely as logging deck yards or lumber stock yards. In places the subsoil, or parent, rock is exposed. Deep accumulations of bark are present where logs have been stored before cutting. These areas commonly show much evidence of equipment traffic. Slopes are 0 to 50 percent.

This land type has no value for farming. Lumber mills, industrial sites, school sites, and commercial areas are on tracts of this land type. Capability unit is Vllls-1.
