# RANGE CAMP 2024

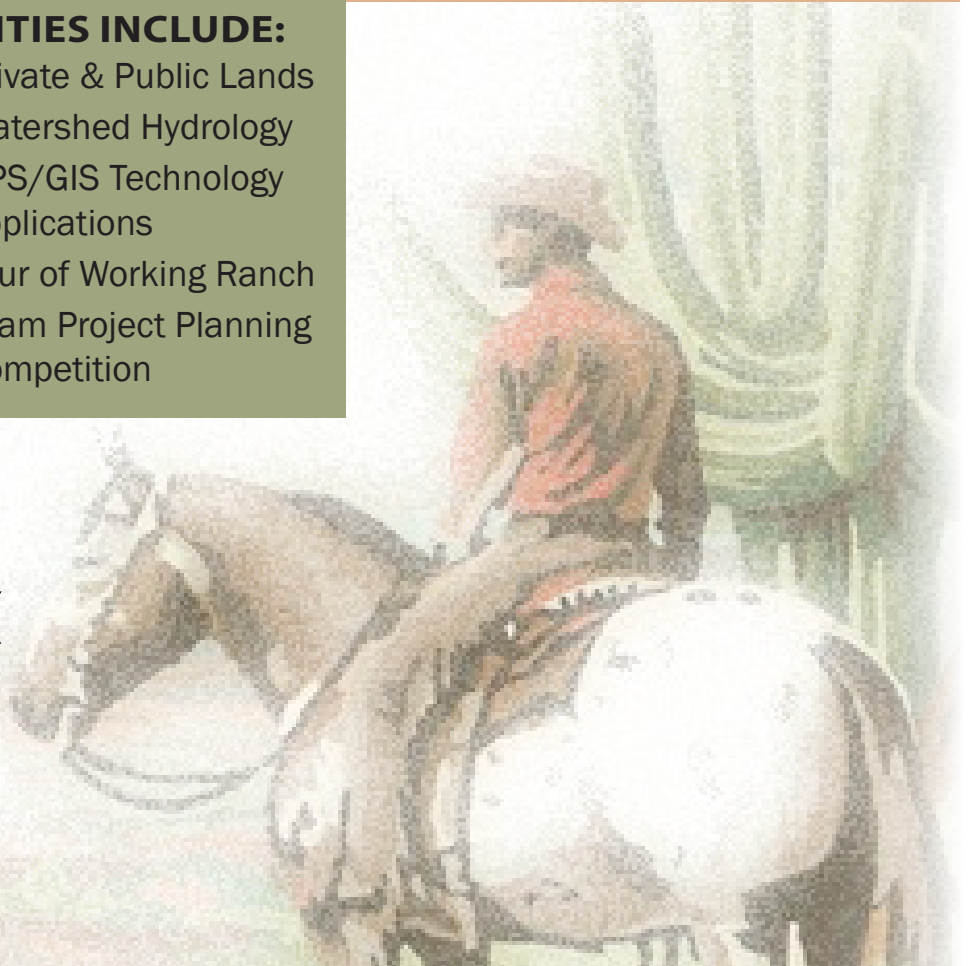
ANNUAL RANGE AND NATURAL RESOURCES CAMP
